



STUDENT PARKING QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

How do I purchase a student parking permit?

- For the 2021-2022 academic year, student parking permits are available for purchase on-line. To access the on-line form, go to: <https://security.press.hollins.edu/>. On the menu at the left, click on Student Parking Permit.
- Students must complete a parking permit application to purchase a permit which records the address of residence, student status, and vehicle information.

What types of parking permits may a student purchase?

- Students may purchase a C parking permit if they are a Commuter Student, Student Senior, Community Assistant, or an executive member of the SGA Round Table.
- Students may purchase an E parking permit if they live at the Student Village, East Residence, or any of the Hill House residences.
- Students may purchase a W parking permit if they live in Tinker, Randolph, Main, or West Residence.
- Students may purchase a Student Temporary parking permit for vehicles brought to campus for a temporary period of time.
- Students may obtain, at no cost, a Student Temporary parking permit if their registered vehicle is temporarily out of service.

How much do student parking permits cost?

- Undergraduate Student parking permits are \$75 for an academic year.
- Graduate and Horizon Student parking permits are \$50 for an academic year.
- Depending on the purchase date, the above fees may be less.
- Additional or replacement Student parking permits are \$5.

Where can a registered student vehicle with a parking permit park on campus?

- C parking permits allow students to park in the East Student Lot, the Randolph Lot, the Tinker Lot, and the West Drive Student Lot; however, there is no overnight parking in the West Drive Student Lot from 11:00pm until 7:00am, Sunday through Thursday.
- E parking permits allow students to park in the East Student Lot.
- W parking permits allow students to park in the West Lots (upper and lower).
- Monday through Friday from 4:30pm until 7:00am and on the weekend, student vehicles with parking permits are allowed to park in the employee lots or spaces, except the Boiler Lot and the Arts/Theatre Lot.
- Monday through Friday from 8:00pm until 7:00am and on the weekend, student vehicles with parking permits are allowed to park in the Boiler Lot.
- Friday from 8:00pm until Monday at 7:00am, student vehicles with parking permits are allowed to park in the Arts/Theatre Lot.

How do I avoid parking tickets?

- To avoid parking tickets, students are expected to properly display a current parking permit and not park in a lot that is not your assigned lot, Disabled Spaces (unless authorized by law), Fire Lanes, Employee Lots or Spaces (during restricted times and days), Reserved Lots or Spaces, Visitor Spaces, two spaces, prohibited zones, on sidewalks, on the grass, against the flow of traffic, or beyond the posted time limits.
- If your vehicle breaks down on campus, in any lot or area other than your assigned lot, please notify Campus Security by telephone or in person, giving your permit number, the reason for the breakdown, and a firm date on when the vehicle will be removed from the lot or area. We do not want to have to ticket your vehicle, we want to help.
